Guest Speaker

Bio-terrorism Preparedness Trainer, Todd Hepworth, gave a presentation on Emergency Preparedness

A few highlights from the preparedness guide include:

- Create a family disaster plan
- Relief workers may not get to you for 72 hours
- Plan for special needs and pets (shelters do not allow pets)
- Make an out-of-town person your contact person
- Each person needs 1 gallon of water per day
- Plan for prescription medication
- Have access to and bring with you copies of all important documents

In case of natural disasters, stand-up clinics will/ be placed in schools. Each community will need to operate their clinic. On Saturday, April 8th, the group will simulate standing up a medical clinic at Arlington Heights High School.
