### 1) TNA "No Soliciting – No Handbills" – Education & Sign Distribution

Your neighborhood association is responding to on-going concerns about solicitors and the extensive door hanging advertisements in our community. We know that, in addition to privacy issues, many of us share security concerns. Our acting Neighborhood Police Officer, Mario Cabello, will update us on the new City of Fort Worth guidelines for your options to reduce or eliminate these activities.

We hope to have aluminum yard signs available for distribution at the meeting. These signs are being provided through

membership funds and a major contribution from Williams Trew Real Estate Services. In the event you are unable to attend this meeting and want a sign we will have these at the next meeting scheduled for October 10. We are currently working through alternate ways to obtain signs. Your Block Captain will be able to assist you in getting one. If we reach our goal of a sign in every yard we should be able to eliminate many of these activities in our neighborhood. ### 2) Neighborhood Association Reorganization
